

Read With Me Program

Who is this program for? Grade 1 - 6 children who are reading below grade level.

What is it? A free Library program that supports your child's reading development in a fun and engaging way. We match your child with an adult volunteer from your community who wants to help your child become a more confident reader.

Where does it take place? At your community Library, once a week for one hour, and continues throughout the year.

When does it take place? It starts anytime of the year and runs for a year. Weekly sessions take place whenever works for you and the volunteer, which is anytime on weekdays between afterschool and bedtime or on weekends.

Why should my child participate? The literacy activities in this program depend on your child's interests, reading level, and the way that they learn. It supports them where they struggle and builds their confidence in reading in a fun way. This program is NOT homework help and learners must understand and speak English.
